

This Up-And-Coming Italian Designer is A Master of Materials

Looking like glossy collages left too long in the sun, <u>Strata</u> — a collection of glass plates and lamps by Venetian designer Lucia Massari for <u>Swing Design Gallery</u> — are vibrant, delicate, and weirdly fun. Massari fuses differently colored flat sheets of glass in an oven, and the results teeter between two and three dimensions. Sticking with a few neutrals and a pop of color or two — yellows, violets, and blues — the casual overlapping of smooth ovals, chunky grids, and basic rectangles create unexpected, but harmonious, geometric textures. With a lamp that looks like an abstraction of a sunset to plates that could be reassembled modern paintings, Massari's works show off both her craftsmanship and her experimental side (which we previously saw in this amazing <u>leather room divider</u> and <u>chest of drawers</u>). An exhibition is on view at Swing Design Gallery until February 24.
